Dear Parishioners and Friends:

For years people have romanticized the name and legend of St. Valentine, and he is surely one of few saints who is known to both the religious and securlar worlds. In this small amount of space, we're going to set the record straight!

During the reign of Claudius the Cruel, Rome was involved in many ugly and bloody campaigns for which the emperer needed to maintain a strong army. It was difficult to lure men to the legions especially if they had a particularly strong attachment to their wives and families, so Claudius addressed the difficulty by outlawing marriage and even engagement.

Realizing the injustice of the emperer's decree, Valentine, a holy priest of Rome, continued to perform marriages in secret, in defiance of the decree. When Valentine's actions were discovered, Claudius ordered his arrest. While in jail, Valentine converted 65 guards and ther families, and for that he was condemned to death. He was beaten with clubs and eventually beheaded. This sentence was carried out on February 14, on or about the year 270 A.D.

Legend tells us that Valentine left a farewell note for the jailer's daughter, who had become his friend, and signed it "From Your Valentine." From a jail cell in Rome to every grade school classroom in America - that's some real enfluence!

Historically, there are three different Saint Valentines, all of them martyrs, but it's likely that the priest of Rome was the martyr that is commemorated. Also of historic fact is that February 14th was the Feast of Lupercall, a pagan festival of love. This may have had a bearing on the choice of date, especially if there was any doubt as to the actual date of execution.

May Saint Vaentine continue to pray for those in love, all who live out their marriage vows, and all the rest of us who live in the love of our Lord.
