A Note of Thanks

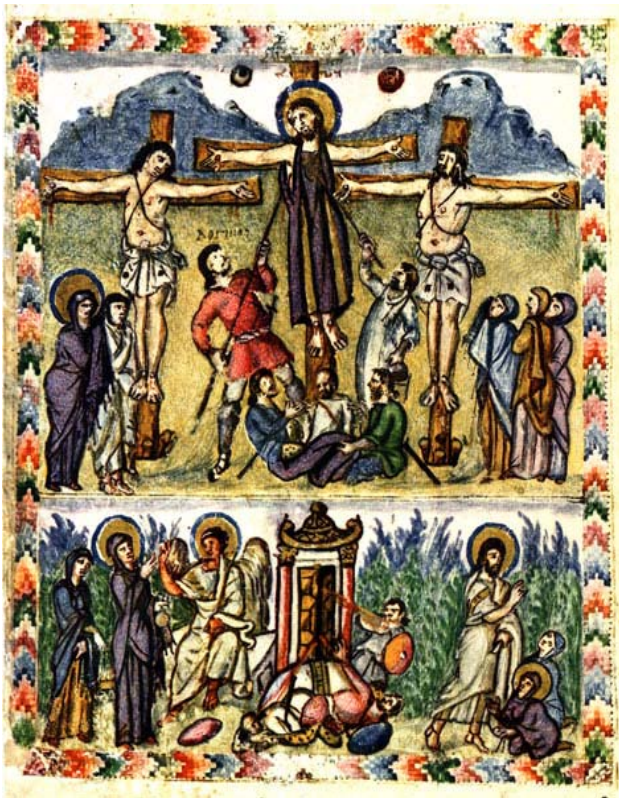
