### Dear Parishioners and Friends:

Justin was born at Neapolis in the year 103 from pagan parents. He was converted to Christianity and was Baptized at the age of thirty. He grew up with a love of knowledge and learning. He went to Rome where he opened a school of philosophy and wrote numerous treaties against the Gentiles and heretics. He addressed, around the year 150, an apology to Emperor Antonius, in which he refuted pagan errors and proving the Christian religion by philosophical and scriptural arguments. He was ordained priest by the Pope. A few years later, Justin wrote another apology in favor of the Christians which he addressed it to the Roman Senate. Pursued by the philosopher Cescens's hate, he was seized with six other Christians. They were all led before Rusticus, the Prefect of Rome. Upon their refusal to offer sacrifice to the idol gods and to obey the Imperial ordinance, they were scourged and then beheaded. Thus their Martyrdom in the confession of Our Lord was consumated around the year 165. May his prayers and those of his fellow Christians be with us.
