He came back to his See when Emperor Constantine liberated the Church. He attended the Council of Nicaea in 325. When Emperor Julian the Apostate took over, he ordered that Dorotheus, at the age of 107, be martyred because of his faith. Saint Dorotheus died in the year 362. May his prayers be with us.*
