Dear Parishioners and Friends:

Recently on our Pilgrimage to Lourdes and Fatima, we spent two days in the beautiful city of Lisbon. It was there that we visited the parish Church in which Saint Anthony of Padua was Baptized. (By the way...the Portugese people insist that we refer to him of as Saint Anthony of Lisbon, not Padua).

He was born in the year 1195. He first entered the Augustinian Order and later became one of the disciples of Saint Francis. He was ordained in the year 1222. He lived a holy life and was noted for his preaching, teaching and writing. He died at the age of 36 on the 13th day of June in the year 1231. Since he spent the later years of his life in the city of Padua, the name of that city was attached to his name.

Saint Anthony was canonized, one year after his death, by Pope Gregory IX. Devotion to Saint Anthony was brought to Lebanon by the Franciscan missionaries in the fifteenth century. May his prayers be with us.
