*Jude was the one who asked Jesus, at the Last Supper: "Lord, why is it that you will reveal yourself to us but not the whole world? (John 14: 22)*

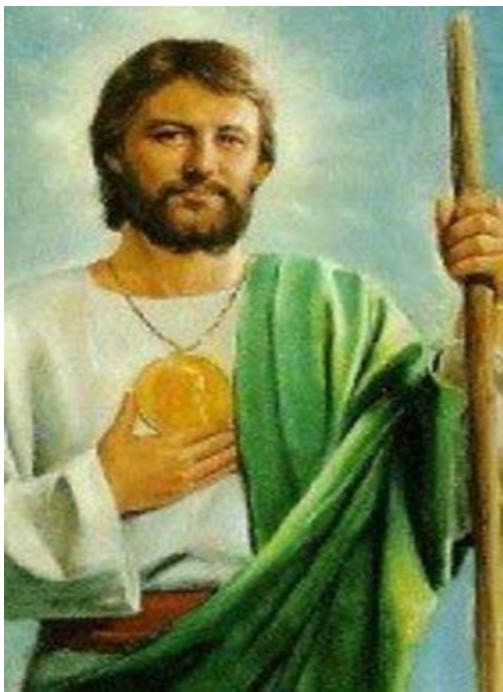
*After the descent of the Holy Spirit, Jude went and preached in Edessa and Mesopotamia. It is believed that he was martyred in Persia in the year 70.*
