# **HELP LEBANON!**

#### **Dear Parishioners & Friends:**

The announcement to Zechariah, the priest, and the conception of his son with his wife Elizabeth in her old age have two important characteristics. Zechariah prayed for years and when God answered his request to have a child, it seemed it was too late for him to accept God's will. He could not believe that God was responding to his call. Thus, the angel Gabriel told him, "Because you did not believe my words, which will be fulfilled in their time, you will become mute, unable to speak, until the day these things occur" (Luke 1: 20). As for Elizabeth, Luke 1: 24-25 reads, "After those days his wife Elizabeth conceived, and for five months she remained in seclusion." Zechariah's muteness at God's miraculous intervention in fulfilling his desire is a common attitude among the people today. There are times when people try hard to avoid shedding light on God's continuous wonders in our lives that the world cannot always see, but are, in fact, extraordinary. We experience them, we can hardly comprehend them and we do not talk about them.

Also, the seclusion of Elizabeth compounded Zechariah's muteness. Why would Elizabeth hide away and wait five months to reveal God's miracle to her? Did she also believe she might not be pregnant? This is an example of hiding God's grace in us which is something else that we practice more than we should today. It was not until only a couple of months before the birth of John that Zechariah and Elizabeth came to terms with God's plan for them. As a matter of fact, Zechariah's hymn of praise and thanks and the loosening of his tongue occurred eight days after the birth of his child at the naming ceremony.

The announcement to the Virgin Mary who was chosen by God to bear his Son by the overshadowing of the Holy Spirit was the opposite to the seclusion of Elizabeth and the muteness of Zechariah. Mary did not accept God's call to her to be the mother of his Son only by saying, "Here am I, the servant of the Lord; let it be with me according to your word." Her conformity to the will of God was manifested as well by her visit to Elizabeth. Mary knew immediately that her mission was to bring Jesus to the whole world and not keep him to herself. Mary the Virgin who was found to be with child was the one who should have felt disgraced and ashamed and should have been in seclusion, and not Elizabeth. But Mary knew better and did not hide away but brought the good news of the birth of a Savior to her cousin Elizabeth in the far-away hill country of Judea. When Elizabeth saw Mary entering her house, she said, "Why has this happened to me, that the mother of my Lord comes to me?...And blessed is she who believed that there would be a fulfillment of what was spoken to her by the Lord" (Luke 1: 43, 45). The Virgin liberated the once-barren Elizabeth from her seclusion because she believed that the Lord was trustworthy. In addition, unlike Zechariah who could not praise God until the birth of John, Mary, even before the birth of Jesus, proclaimed her famous song of praise, "My soul magnifies the Lord and my spirit rejoices in God my Savior" when she was visiting Elizabeth.

Zechariah's muteness and the seclusion of Elizabeth teach us today that God's plan, if we let it, will burst like a spring of water from the earth. For a time, people might be silent about God's glorious works and refuse to cooperate with his mission to bring salvation to the world. Although it might be hindered for a while, God's plan in due time will be fulfilled as we see with Mary.

# Sunday of the Visitation to Elizabeth

### Letter to the Ephesians 1: 1-14.

Paul, an apostle of Christ Jesus by the will of God, To the saints who are in Ephesus and are faithful in Christ Jesus: Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ.

Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us in Christ with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places, just as he chose us in Christ before the foundation of the world to be holy and blameless before him in love. He destined us for adoption as his children through Jesus Christ, according to the good pleasure of his will, to the praise of his glorious grace that he freely bestowed on us in the Beloved. In him we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of our trespasses, according to the riches of his grace that he lavished on us. With all wisdom and insight he has made known to us the mystery of his will, according to his good pleasure that he set forth in Christ, as a plan for the fullness of time, to gather up all things in him, things in heaven and things on earth. In Christ we have also obtained an inheritance, having been destined according to the purpose of him who accomplishes all things according to his counsel and will, so that we, who were the first to set our hope on Christ, might live for the praise of his glory.

In him you also, when you had heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation, and had believed in him, were marked with the seal of the promised Holy Spirit; this is the pledge of our inheritance towards redemption as God's own people, to the praise of his glory.

#### The Gospel of Jesus Christ to Saint Luke 1:39-45.

In those days Mary set out and went with haste to a Judean town in the hill country,

where she entered the house of Zechariah and greeted Elizabeth.

When Elizabeth heard Mary's greeting, the child leapt in her womb. And Elizabeth was filled with the Holy Spirit and exclaimed with a loud cry, 'Blessed are you among women, and blessed is the fruit of your womb.

And why has this happened to me, that the mother of my Lord comes to me?

For as soon as I heard the sound of your greeting, the child in my womb leapt for joy.

And blessed is she who believed that there would be a fulfilment of what was spoken to her by the Lord.'
