Dear Parishioners & Friends:

This following was sent to all parishioners of the Cathedral by mail on March 2, 2021. I am including it in the Bulletin for those whose mailing address the Church does not have.

I pray that this letter finds you in good health, making the best of your time coping with these challenging days. It has been a year since the vicious Covid virus started rampaging through the world, and as a result a lot of things have changed. Parents and children are spending more time together whether at meals or in the evenings often engaging in deep conversation about the meaning of life and the purpose of existence. People around the world are intensifying their prayers together, sometimes through different media platforms. Some have grown in faith and have experienced God's love and mercy firsthand. Others' knowledge of God is increasing as they delve into the infinite wisdom of the Creator and Redeemer.

Yet, the question we ask ourselves today is how can we still celebrate Jesus' triumph over the power of death while half a million have died of Covid since March 2020? Can we be joyful during these unprecedented times? Christianity teaches us that joy comes from inside and it is God's gift instilled in our hearts no matter the circumstances in which we are living. Exterior factors in the world should not determine our behavior vis-à-vis today's challenges. Paul's Letter to the Romans 12: 12 proclaims a very important message for us. "Rejoice in hope, be patient in suffering, persevere in prav-In the hope of the Lord, suffering becomes a prayer and that has sustained Christians for centuries although hidden away, forgotten by many. At the first Easter, the disciples were terrified and "quarantined" from the Romans and the Jews until Jesus was raised from the dead. Then. thev emerged to proclaim his resurrection and theirs. Our goal today is to rise above our disappointments and spread the message of joy whether we are confined to our homes or starting to venture out again. Our ability to shine is not dependent on our surroundings because we are resilient in joy.

On another subject, I would like to remind you that we are participating in the Annual Bishop's Appeal raising \$5,500 during Lent in addition to our regular Eparchial Assessment of \$2000 a month. Your gift will go to educate five seminarians, to provide for fifteen retired priests, to help in Lebanon and the Middle East and to build the Eparchy's Endowment Fund and different ministries.

In conclusion, as a reminder, most of the liturgies and rites during Holy Week will be held at 7:30 pm in person with social distancing and people wearing masks. They will also be livestreamed. The Divine Liturgy of the Resurrection will be celebrated on Saturday at 12 midnight and Sunday at 11:30 am. Those who wish to observe the traditional Maronite practice of fasting and abstinence are invited to follow this practice. According to the Synod of Mount Lebanon of 1736, every weekday of Lent (Monday through Friday) is a day of fasting and abstinence from meat and dairy products (eggs, butter, milk, etc.) Fasting involves eating and drinking nothing at all (except water and medicine) from midnight until noon. The rest of the day normal meals can be taken but without meat or dairy products. Saturdays and Sundays are exempt from fasting and abstaining as are the following feast days: St. Maron on Feb. 9th if it falls during Lent, the 40 Martyrs on March 9th, and St. Joseph on March 19th.

## Letter to the Philippians 1: 1-13

Paul and Timothy, servants of Christ Jesus, to all the saints in Christ Jesus who are in Philippi, with the bishops and deacons: Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ. I thank my God every time I remember you, constantly praying with joy in every one of my prayers for all of you, because of your sharing in the gospel from the first day until now.

I am confident of this, that the one who began a good work among you will bring it to completion by the day of Jesus Christ. It is right for me to think this way about all of you, because you hold me in your heart, for all of you share in God's grace with me, both in my imprisonment and in the defense and confirmation of the gospel.

For God is my witness, how I long for all of you with the compassion of Christ Jesus. And this is my prayer, that your love may overflow more and more with knowledge and full insight to help you to determine what is best, so that on the day of Christ you may be pure and blameless, having produced the harvest of righteousness that comes through Jesus Christ for the glory and praise of God. I want you to know, beloved, that what has happened to me has actually helped to spread the gospel, so that it has become known throughout the whole imperial guard and to everyone else that my imprisonment is for Christ.

## The Gospel according to Saint John12: 12-22

The next day the great crowd that had come to the festival heard that Jesus was coming to Jerusalem. So they took branches of palm trees and went out to meet him, shouting, 'Hosanna! Blessed is the one who comes in the name of the Lord the King of Israel!' Jesus found a young donkey and sat on it; as it is written: 'Do not be afraid, daughter of Zion. Look, your king is coming, sitting on a donkey's colt!' His disciples did not understand these things at first; but when Jesus was glorified, then they remembered that these things had been written of him and had been done to him.
