Dear Parishioners & Friends,

Last Sunday, we celebrated the Feast of Pentecost, the descent of the Holy Spirit on the disciples while they were still in Jerusalem. This feast is the birthday of the Church, the bride of Christ. The Church continues what Jesus started. The Season of Pentecost, which may last as much as eighteen weeks, is by far the longest liturgical season in the Maronite Church. For the most part, the liturgical year is centered on Christ and commemorates events he did in his public life on earth. But the Season of Pentecost celebrates the Church, the people of God working together for the good news of the Gospel to reach the whole world. Most of the readings during the weekday liturgies of the Season of Pentecost are taken from the Acts of the Apostles describing the life of the Apostles and the early Christian community after the Ascension of Jesus.

This Sunday, the first Sunday of the Season of Pentecost, the Church remembers the Most Holy Trinity. The Holy Spirit, the third person of the Trinity, honored last Sunday at the liturgy, does not act on his own, but acts as part of the Trinity, God's A-team to better humanity. The Trinity is defined as three distinct persons, yet of one substance, essence—one nature. The best and the closest way for the human mind to understand and describe this nature is love. It is not only the communion of love that the Trinity has one for another, but also its communicative love toward creation. 1 John 4: 16 expresses this beautifully, "God is love, and those who abide in love abide in God, and God abides in them." The world, the family and the Church are created to be images of the Trinity. Each person in the world, each member of a family, each parishioner at a Church is unique, distinct in personality, yet they are all intended by the creator to work toward that same goal that is love. Love as I said in last week's homily is willing the good of the other for being other. Luke 6: 32-35 reads, "If you love those who love you, what credit is that to you? For even sinners love those who love them. If you do good to those who do good to you, what credit is that to you? For even sinners do the same. If you lend to those from whom you hope to receive, what credit is that to you? Even sinners lend to sinners, to receive as much again. But love your enemies, do good, and lend, expecting nothing in return."

People who tend to love those who are similar to them are not in fact loving the other person, but loving themselves in the other person. That is why Luke said "What credit is that to you?" People can be united to each other in a lot of ways, but at the same time diverse in other ways. This unity in diversity is totally different from unity in uniformity. God does not want people to be copy-and-paste versions of each other or even of him because his creativity which is part of love would no longer be operative and rich. God's love is true and genuine because the divine wills the good of the human who is totally other than him. God unites us with him especially in the Eucharist not only to elevate us to his level of divinity, but to keep loving us endlessly and continuously. If he made us 100 percent like him, we would no longer be other and he could not love us. We are united with him forever, but also different from him—in a lot of ways.
