Dear Parishioners & Friends,

Last week's Gospel passage from Luke 10: 1-7 helps us understand the challenges of evangelization in an unprecedented way. Jesus told the seventy-two disciples as he was sending them before him to the different towns and village, "The harvest is plentiful, but the laborers are few; therefore pray earnestly to the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into his harvest." Nonetheless, many of us are under the impression that the laborers are many and the harvest is meager. Most laity think that spreading the word of God is only the work of the clergy, while in reality, it is the responsibility of all the baptized.

This reminds me of a story of a CEO of a company who would occasionally explain to his workers what it meant to be accountable for the work that they did.

"It's a story about four people named Everyone, Someone, Anyone and No-one. There was an important job to be done and Everyone was sure that Someone would do it. Anyone could have done it, but No-one did it. Someone got angry about that because he thought that it was Everyone's job. Everyone thought that Anyone could do it, but No-one realized that Everyone would not do it. It ended up that Everyone was angry with Someone because No-one did what Anyone could have done! He used to finish the story by looking everyone in the eye and stating very clearly that, 'Everyone, Someone, Anyone and No-one don't work here.' "

If we are true Christians, we are to take responsibility and get into the trenches of evangelization. It seems that most Christian faithful today are "asymptomatic," to use a common word that we have heard a lot the past two years during Covid season. We are Christians, but we are exhibiting no signs testifying that we are God's people willing to take the message of his peace to the entire world.

The fear that hinders evangelization and is alluded to in the Gospel from last week is the unpreparedness overtone of Luke 10: 3-4. "I am sending you out like lambs into the midst of wolves. Carry no purse, no bag, no sandals." Seriously, no Christian wants to hear these words when going on a mission. It seems like Christ was sending the seventy-two disciples out unequipped. If I were a coach trying to help a team and encourage them to win a game, I definitely would not tell them I am sending them like sheep to be torn apart by wolves. I would rather have them go like wolves among lambs, but this is not God's way. He wants us to fully trust him as we go on a mission. And it is not true that Jesus is not equipping the seventy-two. On the contrary, he is giving them his peace so in turn they can give it to those who want to receive it. "Whatever house you enter, first say, 'Peace to this house!'" Jesus' peace is the only weapon we need to go out to conquer the world.

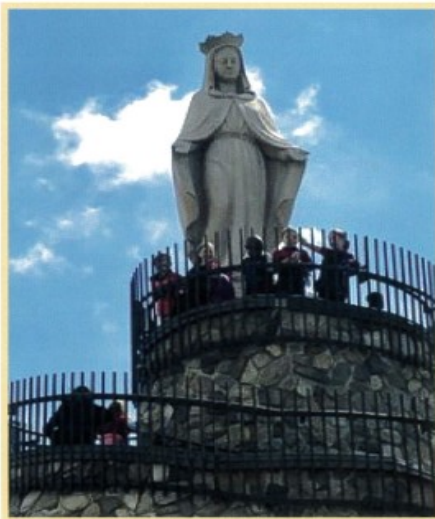

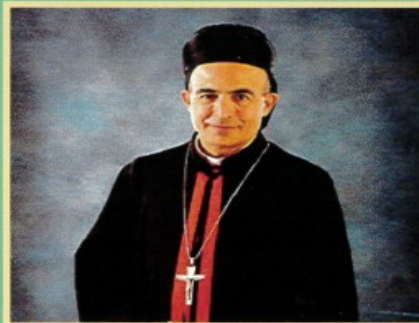

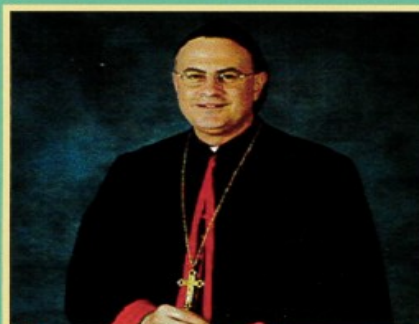

#### Feast of three Blessed Maronite Massabki Martyrs

##### Letter to the Hebrews 12:1-9

Since we are surrounded by so great a cloud of witnesses, let us also lay aside every weight and the sin that clings so closely, and let us run with perseverance the race that is set before us, looking to Jesus the pioneer and perfecter of our faith, who for the sake of the joy that was set before him endured the cross, disregarding its shame, and has taken his seat at the right hand of the throne of God.

Consider him who endured such hostility against himself from sinners, so that you may not grow weary or lose heart. In your struggle against sin you have not yet resisted to the point of shedding your blood.

And you have forgotten the exhortation that addresses you as children 'My child, do not regard lightly the discipline of the Lord, or lose heart when you are punished by him; for the Lord disciplines those whom he loves, and chastises every child whom he accepts.'

Endure trials for the sake of discipline. God is treating you as children; for what child is there whom a parent does not discipline? If you do not have that discipline in which all children share, then you are illegitimate and not his children. Moreover, we had human parents to discipline us, and we respected them. Should we not be even more willing to be subject to the Father of spirits and live?

##### The Gospel according to Saint Luke 12:6-10

Are not five sparrows sold for two pennies? Yet not one of them is forgotten in God's sight. But even the hairs of your head are all counted. Do not be afraid; you are of more value than many sparrows. 'And I tell you, everyone who acknowledges me before others, the Son of Man also will acknowledge before the angels of God; but whoever denies me before others will be denied before the angels of God.

And everyone who speaks a word against the Son of Man will be forgiven; but whoever blasphemes against the Holy Spirit will not be forgiven.
