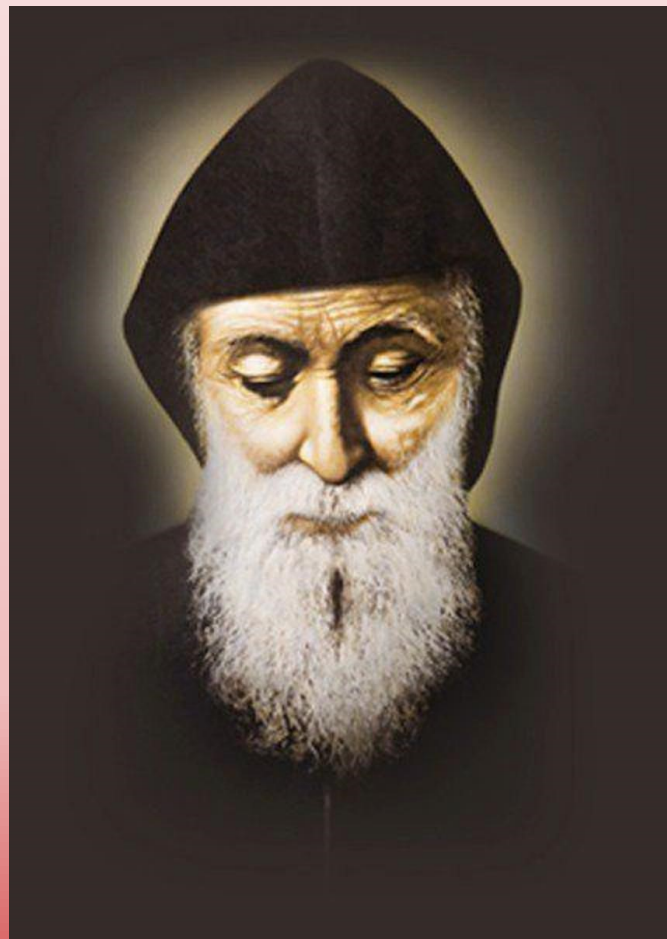

Dear Parishioners & Friends,

I had to travel twice in the last month to officiate at two weddings, one in Mexico and the other in Atlanta. I had not taken a plane since March 2020 when Covid had begun to ravage the world. Except for wearing the mask in airports and on the aircraft, I have to say that things were normal. What did catch my attention were the safety instructions given by the different flight attendants every time before taking off. Toward the end of the demonstration, the announcer usually said, "It is unlikely for pressure to drop in the cabin, but if it does oxygen masks will come down from above your heads. Put your oxygen mask on first, before helping others. Once you affix the mask to your face, you can breathe normally and a continuous supply of air will begin to flow. Although the bag of the oxygen mask may not inflate, oxygen is flowing to the mask." These words of the presentation were not new to me, but it seemed that I was paying too much attention, worrying they would ask for more measures related to Covid, but they did not.

As we are preparing for Deacon Peter Frangie's ordination to the order of priesthood, I started thinking about the wonderful new journey that Peter will be undertaking starting this Saturday after the invocation of the Holy Spirit and the imposition of hands by Bishop Gregory. Even though Peter has been a deacon serving the Cathedral and other parishes for several years, becoming a priest will not only be a new chapter in his life, but a new book all together. It is similar to the taking off of a plane with the thrill and excitement, but also with fear. The safety measure of the oxygen mask falling from above reminded me of the Holy Spirit whose action and inspiration the newly ordained priest will rely on during challenging times. The Holy Spirit is the oxygen that Deacon Peter has been breathing all the time. However, in his new ministry as a priest and especially in times of turbulence and when there is a change in pressure, the Holy Spirit will provide him with a tremendous extra supply. This huge dose of help from the Holy Spirit might sometimes not be seen or noticed similar to the oxygen from the bag that does not inflate though life giving air is for sure flowing.

There was another aspect of the priesthood that helped me make a second analogy with the airline safety presentation. What the newly ordained priest needs to do differently is to help others with the supply of help from the Holy Spirit in times of distress. This goes against the safety protocol put in place by airlines. As a priest, Deacon Peter will be helping the faithful at the risk of his own life. God is expecting him to put the oxygen mask on others, before helping himself.

As passengers put their full trust in the pilot flying the plane to its destination so too the newly ordained priest will learn more and more a new level of trust in God that goes deeper than what he experienced before. In addition to depending on the Lord concerning his own matters, he is now to trust God in things that are related to the flock entrusted to him. And this is a big responsibility Deacon Peter will be carrying as an official and designated priest not just in his own capacity, but in the name of Christ and in the name of the Church.

Congratulations to Deacon Peter on being ordained a priest to serve the altars of the Eparchy of Brooklyn.

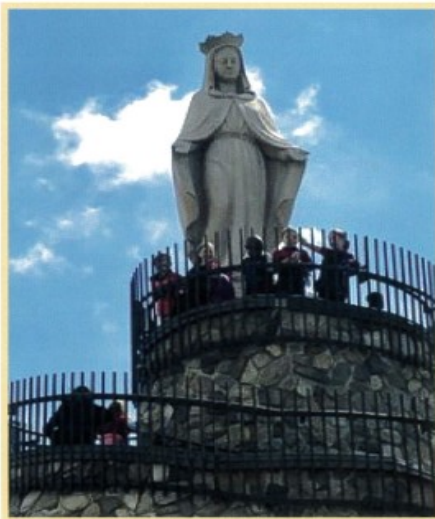

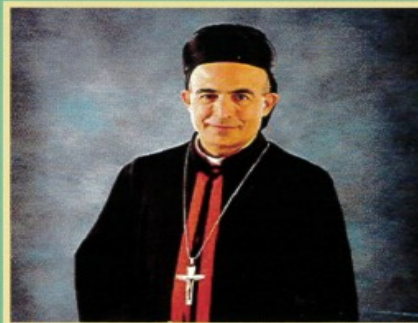

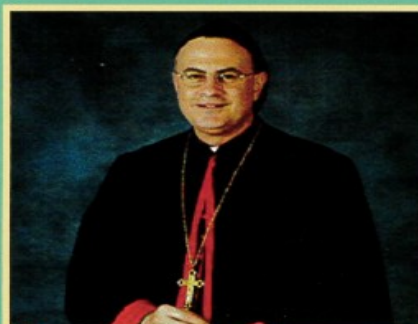

The Feast of St. Sharbel

Letter of Paul to the Romans 8:28-39

We know that all things work together for good for those who love God, who are called according to his purpose. For those whom he foreknew he also predestined to be conformed to the image of his Son, in order that he might be the firstborn within a large family. And those whom he predestined he also called; and those whom he called he also justified; and those whom he justified he also glorified. What then are we to say about these things? If God is for us, who is against us?

He who did not withhold his own Son, but gave him up for all of us, will he not with him also give us everything else? Who will bring any charge against God's elect? It is God who justifies. Who is to condemn? It is Christ Jesus, who died, yes, who was raised, who is at the right hand of God, who indeed intercedes for us. Who will separate us from the love of Christ? Will hardship, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or peril, or sword? As it is written, 'For your sake we are being killed all day long; we are accounted as sheep to be slaughtered.' No, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him who loved us. For I am convinced that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor rulers, nor things present, nor things to come, nor powers, nor height, nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God in Christ Jesus our Lord

The Gospel of Saint Matthew 13:36-43

Jesus left the crowds and went into the house. And his disciples approached him, saying, 'Explain to us the parable of the weeds of the field.' He answered, 'The one who sows the good seed is the Son of Man; the field is the world, and the good seed are the children of the kingdom; the weeds are the children of the evil one, and the enemy who sowed them is the devil; the harvest is the end of the age, and the reapers are angels. Just as the weeds are collected and burned up with fire, so will it be at the end of the age. The Son of Man will send his angels, and they will collect out of his kingdom all causes of sin and all evildoers, and they will throw them into the furnace of fire, where there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth. Then the righteous will shine like the sun in the kingdom of their Father. Let anyone with ears listen!
