Dear Parishioners and Friends,

You might be tired of me by now for repeating in bulletins and homilies how important the reading is for the Feast of the Exaltation of the Cross from the First Letter of Paul to the Corinthians. It actually summarizes the best way for us to understand this Season the focus of which is on the second coming of Christ and the end times. 1 Corinthians 1: 18-25 speaks about how to understand the message of the cross which is nonsense to all who do not believe in Christ, but to us who know Jesus it is the power of God. Then Paul makes it clear why Jews and Greeks do not understand the meaning of the cross of Christ. "For Jews demand signs and Greeks seek wisdom, but we preach Christ crucified, a stumbling block to Jews and folly to Gentiles, but to those who are called, both Jews and Greeks, Christ [is] the power of God and the wisdom of God. For the foolishness of God is wiser than men, and the weakness of God is stronger than men" (1 Corinthians 1: 22-25).

This Sunday the Gospel is taken from Matthew 24: 1-14 where Jesus talked about the destruction of the temple which is a metaphor for his own death on the cross: "Truly I tell you, not one stone will be left here upon another; all will be thrown down." But he also told his disciples that they would hear of wars and rumors of wars and nations rising against nations, and kingdom against kingdom. There would be famines and earthquakes in various places before the second coming and the end of the world. Big signs are anticipated and are reported by Christ himself, but the disciples, who are Jews and are demanding signs, would be distracted by these signs and ignore the cross of Christ because it does not seem to make any sense to them.

Matthew, the evangelist, continued his narrative and wrote, "When he [Jesus] was sitting on the Mount of Olives, the disciples came to him privately, saying, 'Tell us, when will this be, and what will be the sign of your coming and of the end of the age?' " The disciples here were behaving like the Greeks who looked for wisdom or knowledge wanting to know when these end events would take place. Knowledge is powerful but not more powerful than the cross of Christ. The word "privately" demonstrates that the disciple thought they had privileged access to Christ and were privy to some knowledge that others were not. This is also a diversion from the cross of Christ. Christ Jesus became wisdom from God, righteousness, sanctification and redemption, as it was written, "Let the one who boasts, boast in the Lord." In our society, we feel superior when we know something before others do with the attitude "I beat you to it" or "I knew it before you."

St. Augustine wrote in his Confessions, "Late have I loved you, beauty so old and so new: late have I loved you. And see, you were within and I was in the external world and sought you there, and in my unlovely state I plunged into those lovely created things which you made. You were with me, and I was not with you. The lovely things kept me far from you, though if they did not have their existence in you, they had no existence at all. You called and cried out loud and shattered my deafness. You were radiant and resplendent, you put to flight my blindness. You were fragrant, and I drew in my breath and now pant after you. I tasted you, and I feel but hunger and thirst for you. You touched me, and I am set on fire to attain the peace which is yours."

During this Season of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross, let nothing keep us from embracing the cross even when it is, humanly speaking, irrational.

Sunday Readings قراءات الأحد

Second Sunday after Holy Cross First Letter to the Corinthians 15: 19-34

If for this life only we have hoped in Christ, we are of all people most to be pitied. But in fact Christ has been raised from the dead, the first fruits of those who have died. For since death came through a human being, the resurrection of the dead has also come through a human being; for as all die in Adam, so all will be made alive in Christ. But each in his own order: Christ the first fruits, then at his coming those who belong to Christ. Then comes the end, when he hands over the kingdom to God the Father, after he has destroyed every ruler and every authority and power. For he must reign until he has put all his enemies under his feet. The last enemy to be destroyed is death. For 'God has put all things in subjection under his feet.' But when it says, 'All things are put in subjection', it is plain that this does not include the one who put all things in subjection under him. When all things are subjected to him, then the Son himself will also be subjected to the one who put all things in subjection under him, so that God may be all in all.

Otherwise, what will those people do who receive baptism on behalf of the dead? If the dead are not raised at all, why are people baptized on their behalf? And why are we putting ourselves in danger every hour? I die every day! That is as certain, brothers and sisters, as my boasting of you a boast that I make in Christ Jesus our Lord.

If with merely human hopes I fought with wild animals at Ephesus, what would I have gained by it? If the dead are not raised, 'Let us eat and drink, for tomorrow we die.' Do not be deceived: 'Bad company ruins good morals.' Come to a sober and right mind, and sin no more; for some people have no knowledge of God. I say this to your shame.

The Holy Gospel according to Saint Matthew 24: 1-14 As Jesus came out of the temple and was going away, his disciples came to point out to him the buildings of the temple.

Then he asked them, 'You see all these, do you not? Truly I tell you, not one stone will be left here upon another; all will be thrown down.' When he was sitting on the Mount of Olives, the disciples came to him privately, saying, 'Tell us, when will this be, and what will be the sign of your coming and of the end of the age?' Jesus answered them, 'Beware that no one leads you astray. For many will come in my name, saying, "I am the Messiah!" and they will lead many astray. And you will hear of wars and rumors of wars; see that you are not alarmed; for this must take place, but the end is not yet. For nation will rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom, and there will be famines and earthquakes in various places: all this is but the beginning of the birth pangs. 'Then they will hand you over to be tortured and will put you to death, and you will be hated by all nations because of my name. Then many will fall away, and they will betray one another and hate one another.

And many false prophets will arise and lead many astray. And because of the increase of lawlessness, the love of many will grow cold. But anyone who endures to the end will be saved. And this good news of the kingdom will be proclaimed throughout the world, as a testimony to all the nations; and then the end will come.
