

Merry Christmas!

The Season of the Birth of the Lord begins in the Temple of Jerusalem with the Sunday of the Announcement to Zechariah and ends with the Sunday of the Finding of the Lord back in the Temple of Jerusalem. This carries a lot of liturgical significance in demonstrating not only the importance of the Church in our spiritual lives, but in our day-to-day lives as well. The rest of the Sunday Gospels of the Season of the Birth of the Lord generally took place in a home. It is believed that the announcement to the Virgin Mary, the visitation of Mary to her cousin Elizabeth, the birth of John and the revelation to Joseph occurred at their respective houses. As the Temple of Jerusalem-the Church in our day-has been important for God's people, this Season has taught us to make our homes little churches as well.

In the past two years, each home became a little church where the Divine Liturgy was livestreamed on our TVs, laptops and phones and people were able to participate in the different ceremonies held at the Church. But now is the time for all of us to get back to being more active in the life at the Church. The Sunday School had their annual field trip to the Shrine of St. Sharbel at St. Patrick's Cathedral followed by a visit to the zoo on Saturday, November 13th. That same day in the evening, the Maronite Young Adults (18 to 35 years old) had their Friendsgiving Dinner and the Maronite Youth Organization (12 to 18 years old) will be having an event on Saturday, November 20th.

The following are a few more ways you can participate, so you will not miss out during this Christmas Season:

- The Cathedral Christmas luncheon and Christmas pageant will be held on Sunday, December 12th in the upper hall. The Brooklyn Public Library is no longer there.
- *The Christmas Novena will be celebrated every day from December 15th to the 23rd at 7:30 pm (except Sunday, December 19th). A reflection will be given.*
- *The Knights of St. Maron are organizing their yearly Christmas Dinner which will be on December* 10th.
- The Confraternity will be having its annual Christmas Raffle.

Letter to the Romans 1:1-12

Paul, a servant of Jesus Christ, called to be an apostle, set apart for the gospel of God, which he promised beforehand through his prophets in the holy scriptures, the gospel concerning his Son, who was descended from David according to the flesh and was declared to be Son of God with power according to the spirit of holiness by resurrection from the dead, Jesus Christ our Lord, through whom we have received grace and apostleship to bring about the obedience of faith among all the Gentiles for the sake of his name, including yourselves who are called to belong to Jesus Christ, To all God's beloved in Rome, who are called to be saints: Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ, First, I thank my God through Jesus Christ for all of you, because your faith is proclaimed throughout the world. For God, whom I serve with my spirit by announcing the gospel of his Son, is my witness that without ceasing I remember you always in my prayers, asking that by God's will I may somehow at last succeed in coming to you. For I am longing to see you so that I may share with you some spiritual gift to strengthen you or rather so that we may be mutually encouraged by each other's faith, both yours and mine.
