Dear Parishioners & Friends,

This Sunday and the following week the Maronite Church celebrates the Visitation of the Virgin Mary to her cousin Elizabeth. At the announcement to Mary that she would bear the Son of God, Emmanuel, the Angel Gabriel also announced to her that Elizabeth, her barren relative, was six months pregnant with John, the forerunner. In both these events, Luke used two expressions that seemed somewhat foreign to the image of the Virgin Mary we are used to today. Upon hearing the greeting of the Angel Gabriel to her, "Mary was troubled," Luke recorded. The word "troubled" in Greek was used only one time, only for Mary, in the entire New Testament which showed the magnitude of the event that was unfolding. The other instance is the reaction of Mary to her cousin having a child in her old age. Luke, who recorded these events said, "In those days Mary set out [rose] and went with haste to a Judean town in the hill country." "With haste" is not an expression we usually use when we speak about Mary.

The Catholic Tradition describes Our Lady as gentle in dealing with issues, caring when faced with difficulties, calm in demeanor, and a loving mother. Today, I am going to talk about the expression "with haste." Mary, without much thought, quickly got up and traveled to the countryside of Judea to check on and serve her cousin Elizabeth. Our Lady, who had just received the dramatic news that she, only betrothed to Joseph, would have a son, the Savior of the world, could have come up with a million valid reasons not to leave Galilee, her home.

Today, unlike Mary, we are often slow to serve and care. We make up excuses, like I am busy or I do not have time, to avoid fulfilling our main calling in life which is to help and assist others. On the other hand, we are quick to criticize and point out the negative in other people. With haste, we put people down, but only reluctantly do we encourage them and speak highly of their successes. If we delve more deeply into "with haste," we learn that it can mean "with enthusiasm." Etymologically, the Greek word literally comes from *entheos* signifying divinely inspired or possessed by a god—from *en* "in" + *theos* "god." The Virgin Mary rose and went to see Elizabeth and Zachariah with enthusiasm, that is with God in her.

My friends, as we continue the Season of the Birth of Our Lord, let us with haste and without hesitating run to be with those who need us. By doing so, like Mary, we are also bringing God with us.

Letter to the Ephesians 1: 1-14.

Paul, an apostle of Christ Jesus by the will of God, To the saints who are in Ephesus and are faithful in Christ Jesus: Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ.

In Christ we have also obtained an inheritance, having been destined according to the purpose of him who accomplishes all things according to his counsel and will, so that we, who were the first to set our hope on Christ, might live for the praise of his glory.

In him you also, when you had heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation, and had believed in him, were marked with the seal of the promised Holy Spirit; this is the pledge of our inheritance towards redemption as God's own people, to the praise of his glory.
