

Dear Parishioners & Friends,

The Season of the Glorious Epiphany represents an opportunity to discover anew the call we received at the time of our baptism. "In baptism," according to Pope Francis, "we receive the origin of all fatherhood and true motherhood: no one can have God for a Father who does not have the Church for a mother." Hence, our mission "is rooted in the fatherhood of God and motherhood of the Church." Based on this, God's invitation is twofold: to encounter and to evangelize.

To encounter is to spend time with the Lord. This reminds us of last week's Gospel when Andrew and the other disciple of John the Baptist followed the Lord and stayed with him that day. Spending time with him, the two disciples discover that Jesus is not only the Lamb of God as John testified, or a Rabbi, as they first address him, but also the Messiah. The two disciples ask Jesus where he is staying because they want to remain with him and stay at his place. John the Baptist taught them well not only to use Jesus to find solutions for their life's dilemmas, but to focus more on their encounter with him. While strengthening the relationship with the Lord and building a stronger prayer life is great, if we stop at that, Christianity will be like Judaism: enjoying being the people God chose for his covenant but keeping him to themselves and not sharing him with other nations.

The other side of the same coin is to evangelize: to tell others about the encounter with the Lord. The former Rector of Our Lady of Lebanon Maronite Seminary, Msgr. Seely Beggiani, used to repeat to us, "You cannot give what you do not have." We cannot evangelize if we do not experience Christ. Again, last week's Gospel is very relevant here. "One of the two who heard John speak and followed him was Andrew, Simon Peter's brother. He first found his brother Simon and said to him, 'We have found the Messiah' (which is translated Anointed One). He brought Simon to Jesus, who looked at him and said, 'You are Simon son of John. You are to be called Cephas (which is translated) Peter)' " (John 1: 40-42). What Andrew did is evangelize par excellence. After he encountered the Lord, enjoyed his stay with him and learned that he was the Messiah, he brought his brother, Simon Peter, to meet him, so he could, as well, have the experience that Andrew had. When Jesus saw Peter, something extraordinary happened. He called him Cephas which means rock. Giving Peter a new name implied entrusting him with a mission that would be unfolded the more he journeyed with Christ.

The rite of the blessing of the water of the Sacrament of Baptism reveals that God created water precisely for the purpose of baptizing people. This means that when God created water, he was yearning to encounter us through our baptism from the beginning of creation. He also wanted to fill the water with the movement of his Spirit hovering over the face of the waters, to endow us with the power to evangelize.







### **Second Sunday after the Epiphany**

### **Second Letter to the Corinthians 4: 5-15.**

For we do not proclaim ourselves; we proclaim Jesus Christ as Lord and ourselves as your slaves for Jesus' sake.

For it is the God who said, 'Let light shine out of darkness', who has shone in our hearts to give the light of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Jesus Christ. But we have this treasure in clay jars, so that it may be made clear that this extraordinary power belongs to God and does not come from us. We are afflicted in every way, but not crushed; perplexed, but not driven to despair;

persecuted, but not forsaken; struck down, but not destroyed; always carrying in the body the death of Jesus, so that the life of Jesus may also be made visible in our bodies. For while we live, we are always being given up to death for Jesus' sake, so that the life of Jesus may be made visible in our mortal flesh. So death is at work in us, but life in you. But just as we have the same spirit of faith that is in accordance with scripture 'I believed, and so I spoke' we also believe, and so we speak, because we know that the one who raised the Lord Jesus will raise us also with Jesus, and will bring us with you into his presence. Yes, everything is for your sake, so that grace, as it extends to more and more people, may increase thanksgiving, to the glory of God.

### The Gospel according to Saint John 1: 35-42.

The next day John again was standing with two of his disciples, and as he watched Jesus walk by, he exclaimed, 'Look, here is the Lamb of God!' The two disciples heard him say this, and they followed Jesus. When Jesus turned and saw them following, he said to them, 'What are you looking for?' They said to him, 'Rabbi' (which translated means Teacher), 'where are you staying?' He said to them, 'Come and see.' They came and saw where he was staying, and they remained with him that day.
