

**Darb Mar Charbel** is a unique 130-kilometer long-distance pilgrimage-hiking trail project, developed by the Darbessama Association and implemented on the ground by the Lebanon Mountain Trail Association according to international standards and the best practices of world-class pilgrimage trails.

The journey starts at the Monastery of Mar Antonios Qozhaya in the Qadisha Valley and concludes at the Our Lady of Lebanon Shrine, Harissa. The path leads the pilgrim/hiker through Saint Charbel's many stages of earthly life and dwelling locations: birth, spiritual awakening, novitiate, ordination and his cenobitic and eremitic life.

The "Darb" is a source of spiritual enrichment, cultural discovery, physical challenge, and an instrument of sustainable development for the trail's 40+ bordering towns and villages.







## Sunday Readings

### قراءات الأحد

#### Sunday of the Finding of the Lord in the Temple

##### The Letter to the Hebrews 7: 11-19

If perfection had been attainable through the Levitical priesthood for the people received the law under this priesthood what further need would there have been to speak of another priest arising according to the order of Melchizedek, rather than one according to the order of Aaron? For when there is a change in the priesthood, there is necessarily a change in the law as well. Now the one of whom these things are spoken belonged to another tribe, from which no one has ever served at the altar. For it is evident that our Lord was descended from Judah, and in connection with that tribe Moses said nothing about priests. It is even more obvious when another priest arises, resembling Melchizedek, one who has become a priest, not through a legal requirement concerning physical descent, but through the power of an indestructible life. For it is attested of him, 'You are a priest forever, according to the order of Melchizedek.' There is, on the one hand, the abrogation of an earlier commandment because it was weak and ineffectual (for the law made nothing perfect); there is, on the other hand, the introduction of a better hope, through which we approach God.

##### The Gospel according to Saint Luke 2: 41-52

Every year his parents went to Jerusalem for the festival of the Passover. And when he was twelve years old, they went up as usual for the festival. When the festival was ended and they started to return, the boy Jesus stayed behind in Jerusalem, but his parents did not know it. Assuming that he was in the group of travelers, they went a day's journey. Then they started to look for him among their relatives and friends. When they did not find him, they returned to Jerusalem to search for him. After three days they found him in the temple, sitting among the teachers, listening to them and asking them questions. And all who heard him were amazed at his understanding and his answers. When his parents saw him they were astonished; and his mother said to him, 'Child, why have you treated us like this? Look, your father and I have been searching for you in great anxiety.' He said to them, 'Why were you searching for me? Did you not know that I must be in my Father's house?' But they did not understand what he said to them. Then he went down with them and came to Nazareth, and was obedient to them. His mother treasured all these things in her heart. And Jesus increased in wisdom and in years, and in divine and human favor.

#### أحد وجود الرب يسوع في المهيكل

الرسالة إلى العبرانيين 7: 19-11  
 يا إخوتي، لو كان الكمال قد تحقق بالكهنة الأوّي، وهو أساس الشريعة التي أعطيت للشعب، فأي حاجة بعده إلى أن يقول كاهن آخر على «رتبة ملكيصادق»، ولا يقال «على رتبة هارون»؟ فمثى تغيير الكهنة، لا بد من تغيير الشريعة أيضًا. فالذي يقال هذا في شأنه، أي المسيح، جاء من سبط آخر، لم يلزمه أحد منه خدمة المذبح، ومن الواضح أن ربنا أشرف من يهودا، من سبط لم يصفيه موسى بشيء من الكهنة. ويزيد الأمر وضوحاً أن الكاهن الآخر الذي يقوم على مثال ملكيصادق، لم يقم وفق شريعة وصيحة بشريّة، بل وفق قوّة حيّة لا تزول. ويشهد له: «أنت كاهن إلى الأبد، على رتبة ملكيصادق». «و هكذا يتم إبطال وصيحة الكهنة السابقة، بسبب ضعفها وعدم نفعها، لأن الشريعة لم تبلغ شيئاً إلى الكمال، ويتم أيضًا إدخال رجاء أفضل، به تقترب من الله».

#### إنجيل القديس لوقا 2: 41-52

كان أبوا يسوع يذهبان كل سنة في عيد الفصح إلى أورشليم . ولما بلغ يسوع الثاني عشرة سنة، صعدوا معًا كما هي العادة في العيد . وبعد انتهاء أيام العيد، عاد الأبوان، وبقي الصبي يسوع في أورشليم، وهم لا يدريان . وإذا كانا يطهان الله في القافلة، سارا مسيرة يوم، ثم أخذَا يطلبانه بين الأقارب والمعارف . ولم يجداه، فعادا إلى أورشليم يبحثان عنه . وبعد ثلاثة أيام، وجداه في المهيكل جالساً بين العلماء، يسمعهم ويسألهم . وكان جميع الذين يسمعونه مذهلين بذكائه وأجوبته . ولما رأاه أبواه بعثا، وقالت له أمّه: «يا ابني، لماذا فعلت بنا هكذا؟ فها أنا وأبوك كنا نبحث عنك متوجعين». «إفقل لهم: «لماذا طلبانني؟ لا تعلمان أنه ينبغي أن أكون في ما هو لأبي؟». «اما هما فلم يفهما الكلام الذي كلّمهما به. ثم نزل معهم، وعاد إلى الناصرة، وكان خاضعا لهم . وكانت أمّه تحفظ كل هذه الأمور في قلبه . وكان يسوع يُمُّو في الحكمة والقامة والتعمة عند الله والناس».


