DAY 1 – MAY 01 NEW YORK/VENICE

DAY 6 - MAY 06

Minori'' (Minor Friars) in 1209. We then continue to the Basilica of Santa Chiara to see The Cross that spoke to Francis. We will learn about St. Clare, beloved friend of St. Francis and see her incorrupt body in the final resting place of the Basilica of Santa Chiara. Next we visit the exquisite Basilica di San Francesco, which contains the holy relics of St. Francis and beautiful frescoes of his life. Afterwards we continue our pilgrimage to Cascia. We visit the Basilica of St. Rita's de Cascia. Rita came to be known to be as the patroness of abused wives and heartbroken women. Dinner and overnight in Cascia. (B,D)

DAY 7 - MAY 07

ROME

CONTINUED

After breakfast we depart for Rome, the Eternal City, the Holy City. We visit the Basilica of Santa Maria Maggiore, the most important and best preserved of Roman churches dedicated to the Madonna. In the afternoon our guided tour takes us to the Vatican City and St. Peter's Basilica. This is the site where St. Peter was martyred and buried, and which became the residence of the Popes who succeeded him. We visit the Vatican Museums, once papal palaces, including the Sistine Chapel with its masterpiece altar wall painting 'The Last Judgement' and ceiling frescoes by Michelangelo. We then visit St. Peter's Basilica, a vast marble encrusted place of worship housing the tombs of St. Peter and St. John Paul II. There are 11 chapels and 45 altars in addition to a wealth of precious art and sculptures dominated by Michelangelo's spectacular Dome. (**D**)



DAY 8 - MAY 08

ROME

After breakfast we start our day by attending "Papal Audience" subject to His Holiness availability. In the afternoon visit the Colosseum. It rises on top of the **Esquiline Hill** and is the only remaining example of early Christian architecture, even though, over time, it has been further embellished. Next we will visit the Basilica of St. Paul Outside the Walls which is one of the four papal basilicas of Rome, the second largest after St. Peter's. The church stands on the site which is traditionally believed to be the burial place of the Apostle Paul. (B)

DAY 9 – MAY 09

ROME

Today we have a full day at leisure to explore this beautiful city on our own. Farewell dinner and overnight (B,D)

DAY 10 – MAY 10 ROME/NEWARK

After breakfast we transfer to Rome airport for our return flight to Newark, via Munich. We arrive in Newark the same evening. (B)
