Contest Options

Posters

K-1: Draw the story of The Tower of Babel, *Book of Genesis, Chapter 11*

2-3: Draw the story of Jesus Calms the Storm, *Matthew, Chapter 8:23-27*

4-6: Draw the story of Daniel & Goliath, *Book of 1 Samuel, Chapter 17*

7-9: Depict the story of Elizabeth Mother of John the Baptist. *Luke 1:13-14, 24-25, 41-45.*

10-12: Depict the story of the Samaritan Woman at the Well. *John 4:2*

Essays

K-1: In your own words, write a short paragraph telling us what you liked about the story of the Tower of Babel

2-3: In your own words, write your thoughts about the story of Jesus calming the storm (*not to exceed 50 words*)

4-6: In your own words, write your thoughts about the story of Daniel & Goliath (*Not to exceed 100 words.*)

7-9: Analyze the importance of the story of Elizabeth, mother of John the Baptist in the Bible. (*Not to exceed 500 words*)

10-12: What does the story of the Samaritan Woman at the well mean to you. (*Not to exceed 1000 words*)

Prizes (1 per grade group/category)

1st Place: \$100, 2nd Place: \$75, 3rd Place: \$50

Contest Guidelines

1) All entries must be the original work of the entrant. Any entries that are noticeably not the work of the individual student will be disqualified.

2) Each student may only enter in ONE category.

3) NO GROUP entries. This is an individual student competition.

4) Each parish may submit up to 3 entries per category/grade level.

5) POSTERS MUST BE on 14 x 22 Poster Board Paper. Any other paper format will be disqualified.

6) Entries must be clearly marked, on the back, and grouped by age group with a paperclip or divider.

7) Individual participants can mail in their own entries, must indicate parish affiliation, City & State.

8) All entries must have the students name, address, parish name, grade level and age. **(CLEARLY WRITTEN OR TYPED.)**

10) All entries must be post marked by **May 31st., 2022**, and mailed to the below address.
